THE 2023 ANNUAL MEETING WILL BE HELD JULY 18 – JULY 20, 2023, AT THE GREENBRIER, WHITE SULPHUR SPRINGS, WEST VIRGINIA.

The business portion of the Annual Meeting will commence at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, July 19, and will conclude by 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, July 20.

2023 Director Election

In accordance with the Bylaws of AgFirst Farm Credit Bank ("AgFirst"), the following Board seats are open for election:

- Two (2) Regional Seats in Region One one seat with a oneyear term expiring on December 31, 2024, and one seat with a four-year term expiring on December 31, 2027
- One (1) Regional Seat and One (1) Regional Equity Seat in Region Two – one seat with a one-year term expiring on December 31, 2024, and one seat with a four-year term expiring on December 31, 2027
- One (1) Regional Seat in Region Three with a four-year term expiring on December 31, 2027

AgFirst is strictly prohibited from distributing campaign material. The candidate information provided herein is for regulatory and educational purposes only.

Staggering of Terms

As described above, one (1) Regional Seat in Region One and one (1) Regional Seat in Region Two will be subject to one-year terms. Upon the expiration of the one-year terms on December 31, 2024, both seats will revert to four-year terms. This temporary change in terms was approved by the AgFirst Board of Directors ("Board") to achieve a more balanced staggering of terms for future elections.

The one-year terms will not count towards applicable term limits (i.e., three consecutive four-year terms).

The 2023/2024 Nominating Committee determined the slate of candidates, including which candidates were assigned to the one-year seats. The 2023/2024 Nominating Committee will also determine the slate of candidates for the 2024 elections.

Nominations

The candidates are identified on **Exhibit A**, attached to this Annual Meeting Information Statement, together with disclosure/ biographical information for the candidates.

Nominating Committee – The nominees for the open director positions have been selected by the 2023/2024 AgFirst Farm Credit Bank Nominating Committee (**Exhibit B**). The Nominating Committee and workgroups of the Nominating Committee (consisting of committee members from the respective elective regions) conducted searches for at least two nominees for each open seat. The workgroups coordinated with the regional Association Boards and their chairs, as well as their management in an effort to identify two candidates for each of the seats. The workgroups also approached particular individuals regarding their potential interest in being a candidate or their knowledge of other potential candidates. However, the Nominating Committee

was unable to identify two qualified and willing candidates for any of the open seats. The Nominating Committee's efforts to locate at least two qualified and willing candidates for any of the open seats were reported to the AgFirst Board.

<u>Other Nominations</u> – AgFirst Bylaws and election procedures allow for additional stockholder nominations from May 5, 2023 to May 30, 2023. No additional stockholder nominations were received. Nominations for director candidates will not be accepted from the floor at the Annual Meeting.

Stockholder Voting Rights

Voting for the director positions will be held by mail ballot.

Director Elections – Ballots and candidate disclosures for the director elections will be mailed on or before July 25, 2023.

Ballots for the director elections must be received by Elliott Davis no later than noon on October 2, 2023.

All eligible AgFirst voting stockholders as of April 14, 2023 (the "Record Date"), are entitled to vote for the stockholder-elected director positions. Each voting stockholder has one vote that shall be assigned a weight proportional to the number of that Association's voting stockholders as of the Record Date. For the director elections, stockholders shall be allowed to cumulate such votes and distribute them in the stockholder's discretion.

Voting Stockholders

As of the Record Date, the number of AgFirst voting stockholders entitled to vote is sixteen. The weighted vote of each voting stockholder is set forth on the attached **Exhibit C**.

Disclosure Information

Employee, director, and director candidate loans, and loans to their immediate family members and any organizations with which employees, directors, and the director candidates are affiliated were made on the same terms, including interest rate, amortization schedule, and collateral, as those prevailing at the time for comparable transactions with other persons, and did not involve more than the normal risk of collectability. In addition, all disclosure statements required of director candidates pursuant to AgFirst bylaws/policies and FCA regulations shall be mailed with election ballots to the voting stockholders.

Other Business

The agenda for the 2023 Annual Meeting has been provided to stockholders under separate cover. There are no other business matters to be discussed at the meeting upon which a stockholder vote will be required.

Mailing Date and Online Availability of Annual Meeting Information Statement

The 2023 Annual Meeting Information Statement was mailed to all stockholders on June 30, 2023, and was published on AgFirst's website (www.agfirst.com) simultaneous with its mailing. It will be available on AgFirst's website for at least thirty days. Copies of the 2023 Annual Meeting Information Statement are also available for inspection at AgFirst Farm Credit Bank, 1901 Main Street, Columbia, SC 29201.

No incumbent directors attended less than 75% of the total Board meetings and/or any committee meetings on which he/ she served during the fiscal year. No director resigned or declined to stand for re-election since AgFirst's last annual meeting or since the previous Annual Meeting Information Statement because of policy disagreements with the Board.
